Here is some additional information on the Standing Rock High School incident (Internal Use Only Please)

**Briefing Information:**

- Victim reported to IHS staff who then reported to BIA OJS-Standing Rock Agency Law Enforcement personnel. BIA OJS Special Agents and Law Enforcement Officers (LEOs) responded along with BIA OJS Victim Services (VS) and FBI.
- Victim was transported to Fargo for further treatment of serious injuries.
- Seven (7) suspects (students) were identified plus two (2) school coaches.
- No arrests of juvenile students have been made as of 10:56 am Central Standard Time today.
- Two adult students (18 years of age) were arrested and charged tribally:
  - Sexual Assault
  - Simple Assault
- Two school coaches were arrested and charged tribally:
  - Failure to Report Child Abuse
  - Child Neglect
  - Hindering Law Enforcement (lying to investigators)
- BIA OJS personnel are present and actively conducting their investigation.
- FBI is actively assisting.
- BIA OJS Victim Services are assisting.
- United States Attorney's Offices of North Dakota has been notified and an Assistant United States Attorney has been assigned.
